PE Kit

All children must have a PE kit that remains in school.

- Black shorts
- White crew neck t shirt
- Trainers
- Outdoor kit – optional
- Blue/Black joggers and jumper/hoodie



Trainers will not be permitted as part of the school uniform.

Sports clothing is not part of our school uniform.

Jewellery is not allowed to be worn in school. If earrings are worn, they **must be** small plain studs, and for Health and Safety reasons, **must not** be worn for PE lessons. Watches can be worn – but for safeguarding reasons, these must be analogue watches only (ones with hands) not digital or smart watches.

We are again asking that children do not bring a ruck sack into school. As our school continues to grow we simply don't have enough space for them, and they therefore become a H&S risk as they end up on the floor in corridors.

We ask that children have a school book bag which can be stored in the classroom trays.

As we did this year, we will provide the children with a reading pack. Thank you for your support!
