- 3 substantial meals per day will be provided.
- Breakfast will be ‘continental’ style, and will include, cereal, fruit and toast - help yourself buffet
- Lunch - packed lunch for full day off site activity / Hot lunch on site
- Children will play a part in choosing the menu for the week
- Whitehough cater for all religious and dietary needs - just let us know in advance.

Sleeping – a home away from home!

- All residential dormitories are warm, comfortable and 100% secure
- Girls and boys sleep in separate areas and teachers rooms are located close by to allow for plenty of close supervision
- All bedding is provided at the center - one of the very first tasks for all students is making up their own beds!
- Separate showers and toilet facilities are available for girls and boys



What Should My Child Wear:



- Don't worry! To participate in activities at Whitehough you do not need any specialist equipment! What you do need to do is have a rummage around your wardrobe for your oldest clothing and footwear - you will be getting muddy and wet.
