Home School Agreement



At Briercliffe we believe that a child will always learn best when teachers, parents and children all work together. This agreement sets out the responsibilities of the school, the parents and the child in an equal partnership.

The School will:

- Promote positive relationships between all members of the school community – children, staff, and parents/carers.
- Provide a broad, balanced, and challenging curriculum which is adapted to meet the needs of all children and is delivered in a secure, caring and stimulating environment.
- Value and respect every child regardless of ability, religion or culture, ensuring equality of opportunity for all.
- Keep you informed about your child's education through letters, reports, and parents' evenings.
- Communicate between home and school through letters, newsletters, DoJo, and the school website.
- Have a clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy.
- Inform children and parents/carers what the teachers aim to teach the children each term.
- Contact parents/carers as soon as concerns are raised about your child's work, behaviour, attendance or punctuality.
- Welcome you into school.

The parents will:

- Promote positive relationships between all members of the school community – children, staff, and parents/carers.
- Ensure that their child attends school every day and on time.
- Inform the school of any absence, in line with the school's attendance policy.
- Make sure that their child wears the correct school uniform every day, and has all the necessary equipment, including a full PE kit. Please see our website for more details.
- Support the school's approach to ensuring positive behaviour.
- Participate in ongoing discussion around their child's progress and attainment - for example, by attending Parents' Evening.;
- Ensure early contact with school to discuss matters which may affect a child's happiness, progress, emotional wellbeing and /or behaviour.
- Support the school's homework policy; including listening to your child read at home at least 3 times a week and all necessary maths, spelling and other homework tasks;

The child will:

- Always be polite and respectful towards others.
- Have a positive attitude and follow the school values and class rules and routines.
- Take pride in their work and always give their best; aiming to get better all the time.
- Wear the correct school uniform with pride.
- Move around school in a sensible and careful way.
- Read at home at least 3 times a week and complete all homework tasks.
- Always talk to an adult if they need help or are unhappy.
